# NEAR NORTH HEALTH PARTNERS WITH MEDICAL ASSISTANT CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

## Not Your Average Medical Assisting Program!

Near North Health is partnering with the National Institute for Medical Assistant Advancement (NIMAA) to provide Chicago's communities with the opportunity to become trained Medical Assistants at a Near North Health Center.

NIMAA is a nonprofit education institute created by community health centers that trains Medical Assistants to work effectively in today's high-performing primary health care settings. NIMAA's mission is to provide communities with access to education and employment opportunities while addressing a critical workforce shortage of medical assistants nationwide.

NIMAA offers an eight-month training program that combines hands-on clinical experience with an innovative online curriculum. Through Near North Health's partnership with NIMAA, participants will be able to conduct their training at one of Near North Health's eight Chicago-based community health centers while learning how to work as members of the health care team here and in other high-performing primary care organizations.

Because NIMAA is a non-profit institution, NIMAA is competitive and highly affordable compared to many other Medical Assistant training programs. Tuition for NIMAA's program is \$6,000, plus \$760 in fees, and a \$25 application fee. Financing is also available.

### CONTACT TRACING AT NEAR NORTH

Near North Health has partnered with The City of Chicago to combat COVID-19 through effective contact tracing capabilities and services.

In public health contact tracing is the process of identifying persons who may have come into contact with an infected individual and collecting information about the contacts. This is done confidentially. The contact tracing team consists of four trained Case Investigators/Contact Tracers, one Resource Coordinator/Case Investigator, and one Lead Contact Tracer.

Near North Health's lead contact tracer is Mr. John Coleman. The contact tracing team reaches out to all Near North Health patients and people tested at a Near North health center that are diagnosed with COVID-19. The case investigators ensure that people with COVID-19 have the resources they need to isolate. Then the contact tracers follow up with anyone who may have been exposed to the COVID-19 positive person. This is done without revealing who the person with COVID-19 is to others who were in contact with them.

The contact tracing team then educates the exposed individuals on how to quarantine and look for COVID-19 symptoms that may need care. The contact tracing team also offers exposed individuals resources for housing, food, financial assistance, mental health along with provider follow up.

Near North Health has played an integral part in reducing the COVID-19 infection rate in the most at risk Chicago communities, and will continue to provide COVID-19 testing services as the pandemic persists.
